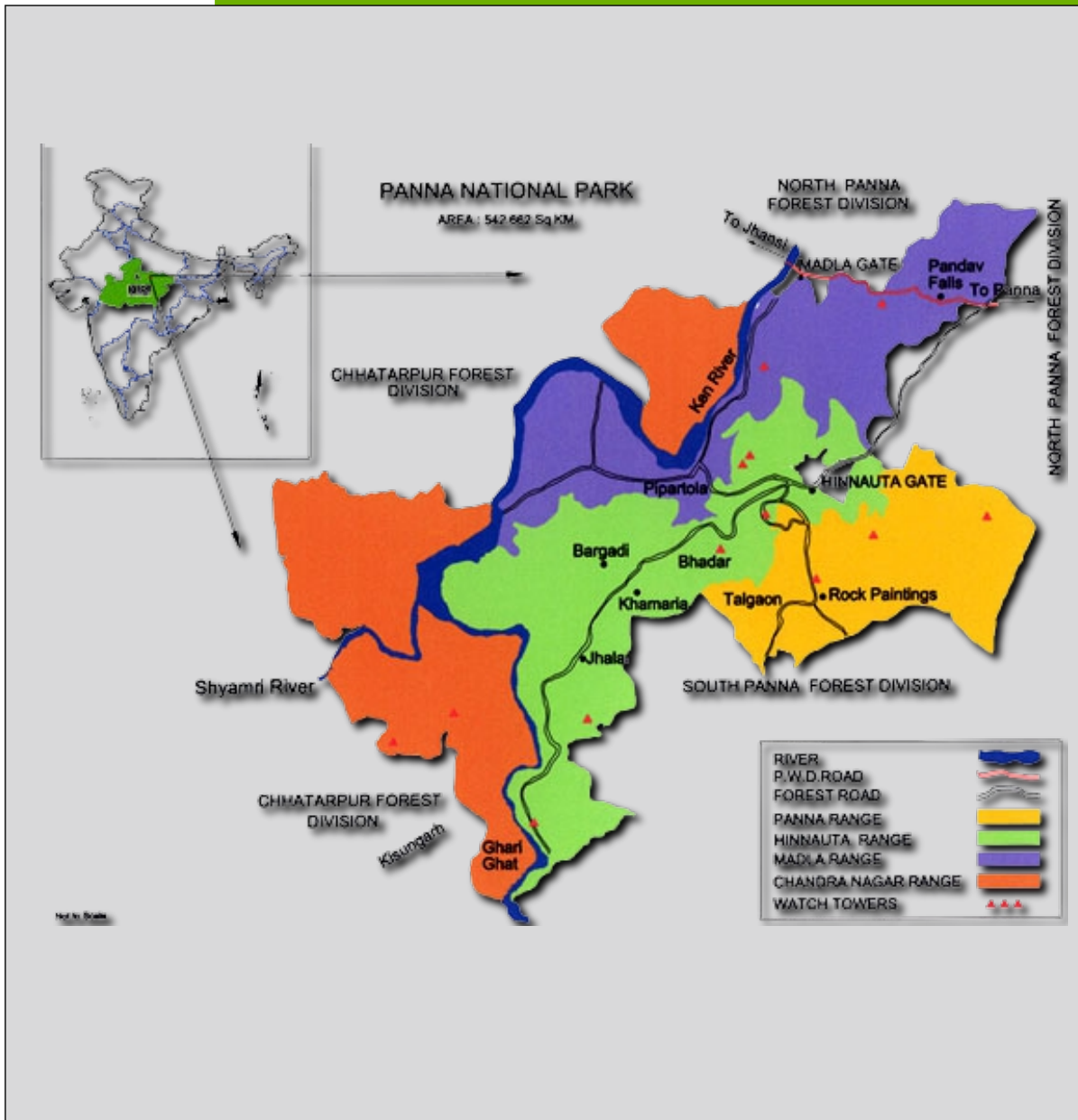


GLORIOUS PANNA...

5 nts. 6 days.

- Day 1 ● Departure from Mumbai - :
In the afternoon, board a train from Mumbai for Jabalpur.
Overnight Journey.
- Day 2 ● Jabalpur - Panna :
Arrive at Jabalpur in the morning. proceed to Panna, enroute we will have breakfast. In the afternoon, Visit Khajuraho Temple Complex.
Comeback to Panna.
Overnight Stay at Panna.
- Day 3 ● Panna :
Early in the morning, go for First Jungle Safari. Take rest.
In the afternoon, go for Second Jungle Safari.
Overnight Stay at Panna.
- Day 4 ● Panna :
Early in the morning, go for Third Jungle Safari. Take rest.
In the afternoon, go for Forth Jungle Safari.
Overnight Stay at Panna.
- Day 5 ● Panna - Jabalpur :
Early in the morning, visit jungle for the 5th time. After breakfast, proceed to Jabalpur. Board a train to Mumbai.

- Day 6 ● Arrival at Mumbai :
Reach Mumbai in the morning.

Panna Tiger Reserve spread over 1645 sq kms. was carved out of the hunting reserves of the erstwhile Panna, Chattarpur, and Bijawar states. Panna was accorded sanctuary status in 1975 and upgraded to a national park in 1981. In 1994, it became India's 22nd Tiger Reserve. Panna is situated at the junction of the Gangetic plains and the Deccan peninsula. The Panna hills provide the catchment area for the Ken River, which is the lifeline of the park. It is predominantly an open forest, offering a great opportunity to see the Tiger and other mammals. It also supports closed canopy forests, open forests with short grass, and undercover, open Savannah woodlands which reflect sub-Saharan habitats, tall grasslands, and degraded scrub. The Ken river, which flows through the Reserve from south to north, is home for Gharial and Mugger, and other aquatic fauna and is one of the least polluted rivers and a tributary of Yamuna. It is one of the sixteen perennial rivers of Madhya Pradesh and is truly the lifeline of the Reserve. Ken offers some of the most spectacular scenery to the visitor while it meanders for some 55 km through the reserve. The reserve which has a bench topography can broadly be divided into three distinct tablelands on the Panna side: the upper Talgaon Plateau, the middle Hinnauta plateau, and the Ken valley. A Series of undulating hills and plateaus rise on the other side of the Ken river in Chattarpur district making it a prime tiger-land located in Vindhyan Hills in northern Madhya Pradesh. Although Panna seems to be one of many ordinary national parks across the country, the park is much more than that. The Park is a haven to many exotic species of plants and animals. The dry and hot climate of Panna Biosphere brings dry Teak and dry mixed forest. The major vegetation of the park is miscellaneous dry deciduous forest mixed with grassland area. It is also home to a great variety of wildlife species. Endangered animals like Tiger, Leopard and Chinkara have found their haven in Panna Biosphere. Other exotic animals like Chital, Nilgai, Sloth Bear, Sambhar are also present in their natural habitat. Panna is also home to more than 200 species of birds including the King vulture, Indian Vulture and bar-headed goose.

Day - 2






Jabalpur - Panna

Reach Jabalpur at 06:00 hrs., proceed to Panna National Park, we will have our Breakfast at Katni. At around 12 noon we will reach Panna National Park.

After Lunch and some rest, we will proceed Khajuraho which is 25 kms. from Panna.

Come back to Resort in the evening. Have Dinner at around 20:30 hrs. Go to bed at 22:00 hrs..

Sightseeing :

Khajuraho is an ancient city known for its magnificent temples and intricate sculptures, located in Chhattarpur district of Madhya Pradesh and 25 kms. from Panna National Park.. As per the historical archives, the Khajuraho temple site had 85 temples during the 12th century spread over 20 sq. kms. Among these, only 25 temples have survived the course of time, spread over 6 sq. kms. 'Khajuraho Group of Monuments' is famous for its Nagara-Style architecture and graceful sculptures of nayikas (Hindu Mythological female protagonists) and deities.








Day - 3

Panna

Early in the morning, you will receive a wake-up call at around 05:15. Tea, coffee, and biscuits will be available. You will have the chance to explore the incredible wildlife with a knowledgeable forest guide. You will return to the lodge by 11 a.m. after the first safari. Take Rest. After Lunch, explore the other area of the National Park which will be our Second Jungle Safari. Come back to resort at 19:00 hrs. At High tea, we will be having interactive session on wildlife. Have Dinner at around 20:30 hrs. Go to bed at 22:30 hrs..

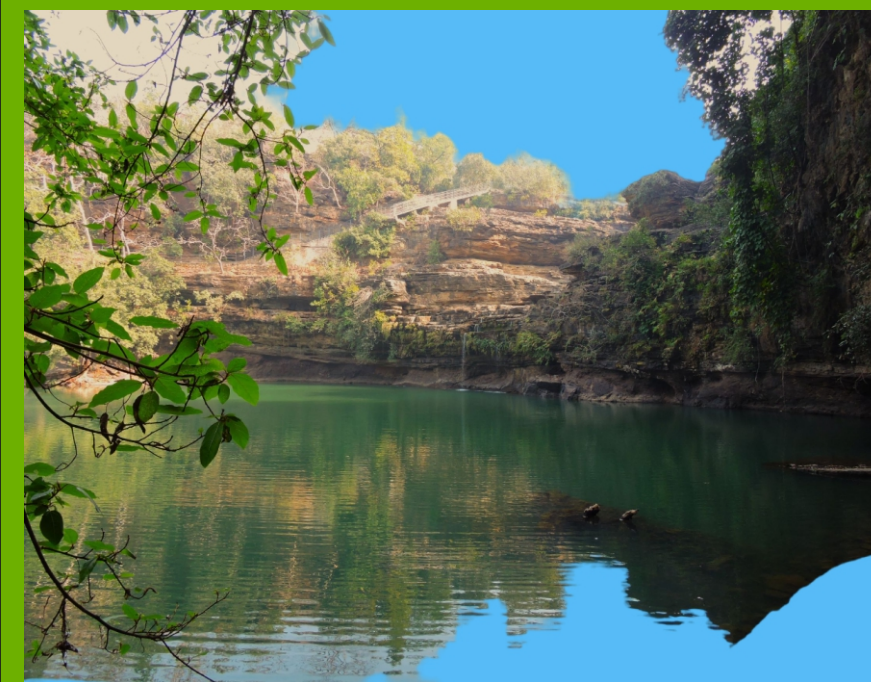
Day - 4

Sightseeing :

In total, Panna has 3 entry gates namely Madla, Hinauta and Akola where you can enter and explore this beautiful forest. The terrain of the reserve is characterised by extensive plateaus and gorges. The reserve which has a bench topography, can broadly be divided into three distinct tablelands on Panna side: the upper Talgaon Plateau, the middle Hinnauta plateau and the Ken valley. Pandava cave is located within the territory of the Panna National Park has great historical significance. As the name suggests this is the place where the Pandavas sought haven during their exile.



Day - 5

Panna - Jabalpur

Early morning's Fifth and Final Safari will be our last chance of trailing the various Flora and Fauna. Come back to resort at 11:00 hrs. After fresh n up and lunch, we will transfer to Jabalpur. Reach Jabalpur Railway station and board the train to Mumbai.

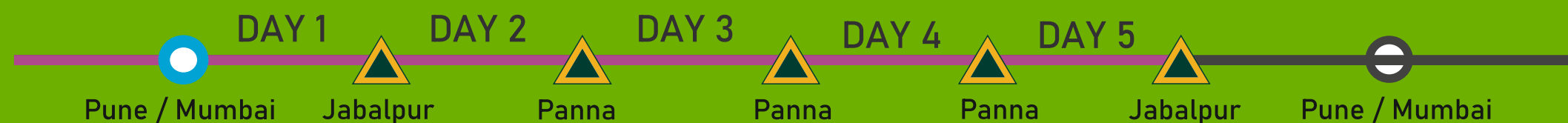

Sightseeing :

Panna National Park is a magnificent wilderness that provides a habitat for a wide range of permanent bird species such as Drongos, Peacocks, Flycatchers, Eagles, Owls, Owlets, Falcon and many more and migratory bird species, such as Kestrel and Vultures. It is also home to various fascinating animals like leopards, Indian bison, langurs, wild boar, and jackals. Of course, the Royal Bengal Tiger stands out as the most majestic and powerful among them. Apart from the impressive tiger population, the park is renowned for its diverse and rich flora and fauna, making it a true haven for nature enthusiasts.
