Known as the 'City of War', this area was earlier known as 'Ranastambhpura'. Located right in the heart of Ranthambore National Park, Ranthambore Fort is one of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites under "Hill Forts of Rajasthan". Ranthambore Fort is located in the vast and arid regions of Rajasthan surrounded by the Vindhya and Aravali mountain ranges. The name 'Ranthambhor' or 'Ranthambor' derives from the two hills Rann and Thambor which are very close to each other. The fort is situated on the Thambore hill at an altitude of 481 meters above the sea level and the Ran hill is adjacent to the Thambore hill. This magnificent fort is 200-300 meters high from the base. Ranthambore Fort has witnessed many sieges and wars. Due to its strategic location, it was easy to intercept the enemy. This fort has played an important role in the history of Rajasthan. This Ranthambore fort was built in the 10th century AD by the kings of the Chauhan dynasty. Temples, tanks, grand gates and huge walls have been built while building this fort. Considered to be an architectural marvel, the fort has many historical and architectural landmarks such as the magnificent Toran Dwar, Mahadev Chhatri, Sametonki Haveli, Bada Mahal, Hamir Mahal and Kacheri, Fashi Ghar, Thirty-two Pillared Chhatri and Dhula Mahal. Similarly there are seven beautifully constructed carved gates, also known as 'poles', namely - Navlakha pole, Hathi pole, Ganesh pole, Andheri pole, Delhi pole, Sat pole and Suraj pole.

Ranthambore Fort has three main temples. Three Hindu temples dedicated to Ganeshaji, Shivaji and Ramlallaji are built of red Karauli stone in the 12th and 13th centuries. There is also a Jain temple of Lord Sumatinath and Sambhava Nath. Apart from that we also find mention of Annapurna Devi as its place. Among them Trinetra Ganesha Temple is the most famous temple and it is situated on top of the fort. This form of Ganesha attracts devotees from all over India including nearby towns and villages. The Ranthambore National Park is abundant in flora due to ample water supply, despite low rainfall in the desert region. With around 300 plant species, including deciduous trees, the park features perennial lakes, steps, hills, and plateaus. Dhok trees cover 80% of the area. The park altogether a mind-blowing place. The climate and vegetation, both are unique in themselves. There are around 320 species of birds found that includes both resident and migratory. Also, there are 40 mammal species and more than 35 species of reptiles which is the major tourist attraction. Besides tigers, the park also has a variety of wild cats like leopards, caracal, jungle cats, and rusty-spotted cats. Also, there reports of fishing cats and leopards cats as well. Sambhar, wild boar, Indian wild cats, jackal, extremely rare wolf are commonly found at this place. Because of varied terrain and abundance of water bodies, the excellent population of birds, residents, and migrants are found here.

Ranthambore, was previously a private & exclusive hunting reserve of the Jaipur royal family until 1955 when the forest was declared 'Sawai Madhopur Sanctuary'. The practice of issuing game permits finally came to an end in 1973 when this sanctuary was declared a part of Project Tiger, Today, this Project National Park spans over 1334 sq. km of area, of which 282 sq. km is the Ranthambore National Park.








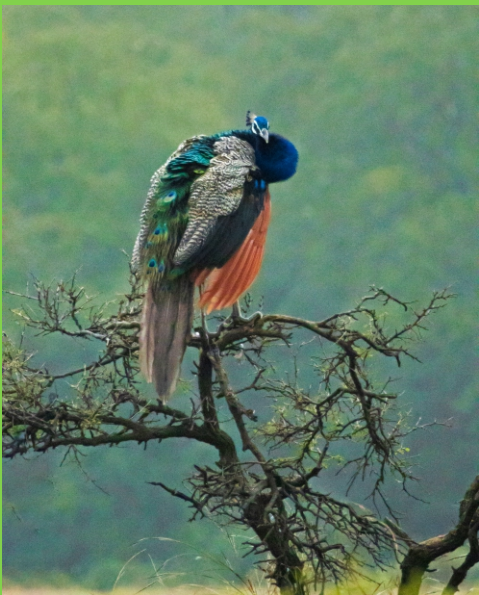
Day - 4

The key focus of the national park is the protection of endangered Bengal tiger. 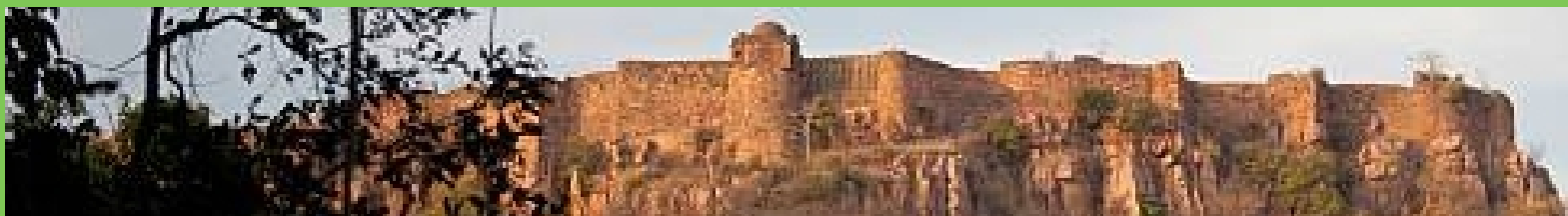
