- Day 01** ● Departure from Pune or Mumbai :-
Early in the morning, board a train from Pune or Mumbai for Leh.
Rest for the day. Overnight Stay at Leh.
- Day 02** ● Leh Local :-
After breakfast, visit the places nearby Leh city. Overnight Stay at Leh.
- Day 03** ● Leh - Khardung La - Nubra :-
After breakfast, proceed to Nubra valley.
Enroute, visit Khardung La. Overnight Stay at Nubra.
- Day 04** ● Nubra - Turtuk - Nubra :-
After breakfast, proceed to Turtuk Village on POK border.
Visit Zero point. Overnight Stay at Nubra.
- Day 05** ● Nubra - Shyok - Pangong :-
After breakfast, proceed to Tso Pangong, Visit Agham, Shayok, Durbuk, Yangtse
Relax at the Pangong Lake.. Overnight Stay at Tso Pangong.
- Day 06** ● Pangong - Hanle :-
After breakfast, proceed to Hanle., world'd highest observatory.
Overnight stay at Hanle.
- Day 07** ● Hanle - Tso Moriri :-
After breakfast, proceed to Tso Moriri via Mahe Bridge.
Overnight stay at Tso Moriri.
- Day 07** ● Tso Moriri - Leh :-
After breakfast, proceed to Leh vis Tso Kar and Tangling La..
Overnight stay at Leh.
- Day 09** ● Leh :-
After breakfast, proceed to visit Stok, Shey, Thiksey. Overnight stay at Leh.
- Day 10** ● Arrival at Pune or Mumbai :-
In the afternoon, board a flight from Leh to reach Pune or Mumbai.

Leh is where your adventure in Ladakh begins! Leh is the capital city of the recently formed union territory of Ladakh. Leh, town, Ladakh union territory, northern India, located in the valley of the upper Indus River at an elevation of 3,520 metres), surrounded by the towering peaks of the Ladakh Range. It is a reflection of the adventurous spirit and cultural richness of North India. Leh has something special to offer every kind of traveler. There are several must-see places for history and culture lovers i.e. Leh Palace, which is seated atop a mountain and offers stunning views of the city Shanti Stupa, which is perched on a mountain and is widely acclaimed for its peaceful ambiance and panoramic views. War Museum, which gives visitors a detailed insight into the wars in India and the role of the Indian Army. The confluence of Indus and Zaskar rivers in Nimmu; the sacred Sikh gurudwara, Patthar Sahib; Magnetic Hill, known for its optical illusion; are some of the major places to visit for tourists. Ladakh's richest monastery, Hemis Gompa; the oldest monastery, Alchi Gompa; Thiksey monastery; Matho Monastery, Spituk Gompa, and other monasteries are ideal for history lovers as well as culture enthusiasts. Visiting the attractions of Ladakh unlocks the chance of great experiences as these places have a lot of natural beauty. Ladakh with a unique characteristic that is a blend of Indian, Tibetan as well as Buddhism linings makes it a place that is worth paying a visit to. The popular Ladakh sightseeing places are Khardung La, Nubra Valley, Turtuk, Pangong Lake, Hanle, Tso Miriri, Tso Kar, Tangling La.

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Day - 1

Pune / Mumbai to
Leh via Delhi

As per our itinerary, we will be starting the journey from either Pune or Mumbai airport. From there, we will have a layover of 4 hours at Delhi airport before reaching Leh airport at 13:20 hrs.

Info :

Acclimatization is one of the important things to prepare for while planning a trip to Ladakh. Leh and most of the places in Ladakh are located above the altitude of 10,000 feet. Thus, visitors may suffer from dizziness, headaches or even acute mountain sickness (AMS). So acclimatization to the high altitude condition becomes one of the most important things to prepare for before planning a trip. Keep a day free to simply acclimatize. Proper rest must be taken every day. Enough sleep, good food and no exertion will help your body get used to the heights, and low oxygen.








Day - 2

Leh Local

Breakfast's ready - let's hurry and get it done. After that, we're off to explore the wonders of Leh city. We will see sacred places like Gurudwaras, Temple, and old Monasteries or Gompas. Rivers, Natural Sights, army bases are some of the other highlights on our itinerary!

Sightseeing :

17th century Leh Palace, built in traditional Tibetan style, which offers breathtaking views of the town. Shanti Stupa, enshrined by the 14th Dalai Lama which was built in 1991 by Japanese Buddhist Bhikshu, Gyomyo Nakamura. This location which provides panoramic views of the surrounding landscape. Magnet Hill is a gravity hill which creates the optical illusion of a hill. Objects on the hill road may appear to roll uphill in defiance of gravity. Sangam point where Sindhu and Zaskar rivers meet which flows to Pakistan. The Hall of Fame, an Army museum built in the memory of the soldiers of the Indo-Pak wars and a documentary film on Kargil War.



Day - 3

Leh - Khardung La - Hunder (Nubra Valley)

After breakfast, drive to Khardung La (5,350 mtrs.), one of the world's highest motorable pass. Spend 15-20 minutes at the Pass and drive downwards to Nubra Valley. After Lunch at Khalsar, explore the Desert and Diskit Monestery. Have Dinner at around 20:30 hrs. Go to bed at 22:00 hrs..

Sightseeing :

The Nubra valley tour starts with crossing the Khardung La, the world's 2nd highest motorable road at an altitude of 5,602 mtrs. above sea level. Khardung La connects Leh to the Nubra valley and it is strategically important to the Indian military force to carry supplies to the soldiers posted at the Siachen glacier near the India-Pakistan border. Diskit monastery is the largest gompa in the valley, it was built in the fifteenth century on the side of rocky hill. A gigantic 32-metre-tall statue of Maitreya Buddha is located a few hundred meters away from the monastery. Ten kilometres after Diskit, you can enjoy a double-humped Bactrian camel ride at Hunder sand dunes.





Day - 4

Khardung La - Turtuk - Khardung La

After breakfast, drive to Turtuk village (3,000 mtrs.), last village in Ladakh region sharing the border with LOC (Pakistan). Spend some of your time at LOC listening to some interesting stories from the locals. Visit museum and later return back to Nubra for a night halt. Have Dinner at around 20:30 hrs. Go to bed at 22:00 hrs..

Sightseeing :

Turtuk tour is known not only for its scenic beauty but also for the reason that it shares a border with Pakistan. Considered the northernmost point of India, it's the only border area in Ladakh accessible for the tourists. The village has an interesting history. Turtuk, along with its three villages Tyakshi, Chalunkha and Dhothang, was once a part of Baltistan in Pakistan Occupied Kashmir. However, in the 1971 war between India and Pakistan, Turtuk was brought under India. Due to this peculiar past, Turtuk offers a distinctive Balti culture to witness. From their dresses to their cuisine, it's a unique village not just in Nubra valley but in Ladakh as well. The inhabitants speak Balti language.



Day - 5

Nubra - Tso Pangong

After breakfast, drive to Sumur village. Then, follow the Shayok road and head to Pangong lake via Tangtse. You could have lunch in a restaurant in Tangtse.

Reach Pangong at around 17:00 hrs. Experience the brackish water of Pangong. Enjoy the Photography session at Pangong.


Have Dinner at around 20:30 hrs. Go to bed at 22:00 hrs..

Sightseeing :

Pangong lake is a gem of the Ladakh region and known for its mesmerizing beauty, breathtaking views and also for its strategic importance. This 140-kilometre-long salt lake is located at an altitude of 4,250 metres, 30% of the lake is in India whereas the other part is in Tibet. This Himalayan wetland reserve is an important breeding site for migratory birds. Spangmik is a small village on the bank of the lake where inhabitants rear pashmina goats.








Day - 6

Tso Pangong - Hanle

After breakfast, drive to Hanle. Today's journey will be adventurous. We will visit War Memorial situated near Rezing La. We will be driving in cold desert and Sindhu river. If we are lucky, we can see the rare species i.e. Black Necked Cranes, Golden Eagle and Wild Ass. Reach Hanle at around 16:30 hrs. Visit the Indian astronomical observatory. Have Dinner at around 20:30 hrs. Go to bed at 22:00 hrs..

Sightseeing :

Hanle is one of the largest villages in Ladakh region, known predominantly as the place which is home to the Hanle Monastery. Located along the Hanle River, this hamlet lies on the old branch of the ancient Ladakh-Tibet trade route. You can also find the Indian Astronomical Observatory which has the third highest optical telescope in the world on your visit to Hanle. The presence of the Indian Astronomical Observatory makes this village quite famous. This observatory is the best spot in the whole country to observe the skies and indulge in stargazing as it is located 4,500 m above sea level.



Day - 7






Hanle - Tso Moriri

After breakfast check out and drive to Tso Moriri via Ya Ya Tso (Lake) enroute cross Nurpa Pass (16,100 Ft) later cross Mahe Bridge, on the way to the Lake..

Arrival at Korzok by late noon. Evening take a walk around the lake to enjoy the scenic beauty.

Sightseeing :

Picturesquely located in secluded, breathtakingly beautiful Rupshu Valley, the high-altitude Tso Moriri Lake is less than 250 kilometers southeast of Leh. Flanked by lofty mountains, this serene lake is about 4,000 meters above sea level. Tso Moriri is approximately 29 kilometers long and up to 8 kilometers wide. It is the largest high altitude lake in India that is entirely in Indian Territory. Tso Moriri attracts a range of wildlife, including migratory birds, marmots and rarely the Tibetan wolves. The beautiful multi shades of blue color offered by this lake along with a picturesque landscape around gives this place an extremely romantic feel and breathtaking feel.



Day - 8

Tso Moriri - Leh

After breakfast check out from Tso Moriri and proceed to Leh passing Puga (Sulphur Mine), Tso Kar, Tanglang La 17,585ft, 2nd Highest motorable road in the world. Enroute we will visit Hemis Monastery. Arrival at Leh by evening.


