

Echoes of the Jungle : Panna

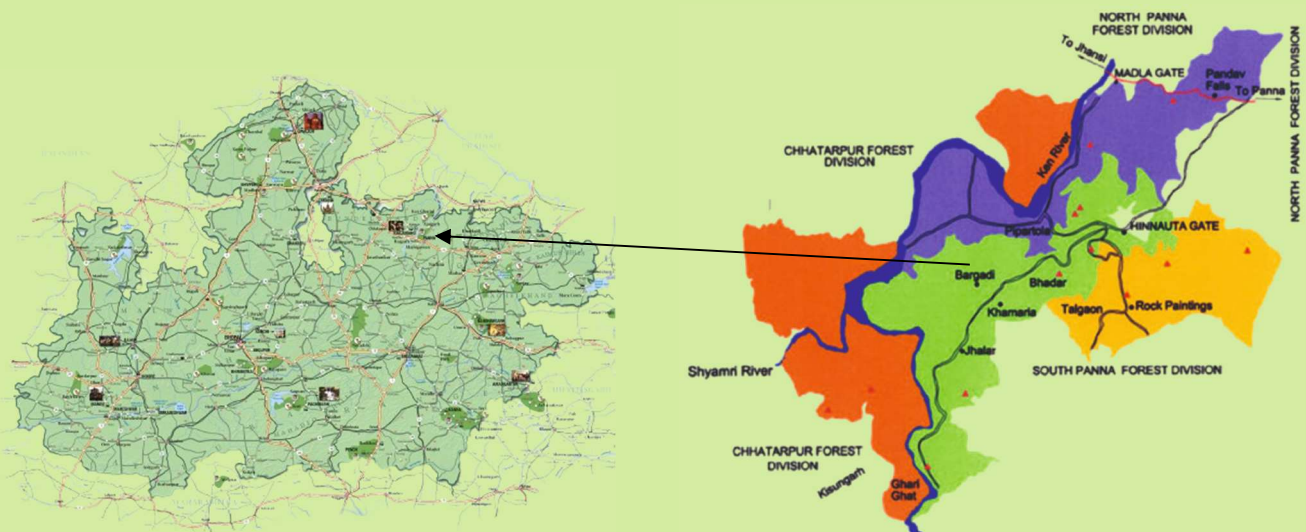
Panna National Park is a tiger reserve spread across Panna and Chhatarpur districts in Madhya Pradesh, India. It covers 542.67 km² and was declared India's 22nd tiger reserve and Madhya Pradesh's 5th in 1994. This forest, along with the Ken Gharial Sanctuary, forms a key part of the Ken River's catchment. The Ken is one of Madhya Pradesh's 16 perennial rivers, and its winding course creates some of the most dramatic scenery in the park. Panna has a lower density of Royal Bengal tigers compared to Bandhavgarh and Kanha, but its open terrain makes sightings special when they happen. Sal and kardhai are the dominant trees here, giving the forest a unique character. There are three entry gates to the park. Madla Gate is the most convenient from Panna town. Hinauta Gate is the second entry point, located 16 kms from Madla. Akola is the third entry point, located 32 kms. from Madla.

Getting there:

Satna Railway Station, 80 km away, is the nearest railhead. Khajuraho Airport, just 35 km away, is the closest airport. Beyond wildlife, Panna offers rich cultural, historical, and spiritual experiences. Its biggest advantage is proximity to Khajuraho – the UNESCO World Heritage temple town already on the global tourism map. You get tigers + temples in one trip.

Climate:

Panna falls in the tropical monsoon zone with distinct winters, summers, and rains. Temperatures range from 5.2°C to 44°C. Average rainfall is 152 cm, mostly during the monsoon. The park also gets some cyclonic rains between November and February.

Tour Itinerary for 5 Nights / 6 Days.

Day 1 : Pune - Mumbai - Jabalpur :-

We will start our journey from Pune in the morning by Deccan Queen or Pragati Exp. to reach Mumbai (CST). In the afternoon we will board Garibrath Exp. for Jabalpur at 13:30 hrs.

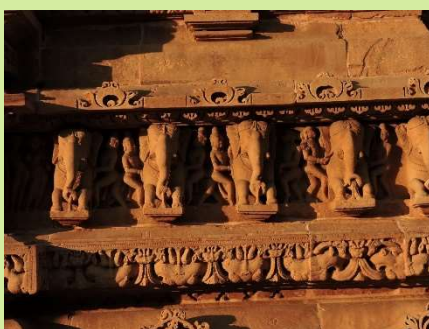
Overnight Journey. (No Food Included)

Day 2 : Jabalpur - Panna :- (235 kms. 5 hrs.) Panna - Khajuraho - Panna (50 kms.)

We will arrive at Jabalpur Railway Station at 06:00 hrs, and set off immediately for **Panna National Park**. The drive will carry us through rustic landscapes, and by 11:00 hrs we will reach the resort, ready to unwind and soak in the wilderness atmosphere.

After lunch, we will begin our journey to Khajuraho, home to the sacred temples that stand as UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Renowned for their intricate sculptures, these temples are often referred to as the “Kamasutra temples,” a testament to their bold artistic expression. Rising against the backdrop of the Vindhya hills, Khajuraho offers a magnificent panorama to every beholder. The temples are most famous for their evocative carvings—depicting everything from celestial nymphs to scenes of human passion and mythological tales. Of the original 85 temples, only 20 remain today, yet they continue to embody the essence of Khajuraho’s allure and remain the centrepiece of its tourism. Come back to Panna at 21:00 hrs.

Day 3 : Panna :-

At first light, we will venture into Panna National Park aboard our gypsy for the **First Jungle Safari**. The trail winds through endless stands of stately Saag (teakwood) forests, open grassy meadows, and shimmering watering holes where herds of spotted deer and sambar gather. Deep within the reserve’s core zone lies a hidden marvel — the Dhundhuwa Falls. This dramatic, horseshoe-shaped cascade plunges into a jagged gorge, unveiling a pristine wilderness untouched by time.

After lunch, the adventure resumes with our **Second Jungle Safari**. As the afternoon sun mellows, the jungle glows golden, every leaf and blade of grass bathed in amber light. Silence reigns, broken only by sudden rustles in the undergrowth that keeps the senses on edge. Each moment holds promise – pugmarks pressed into the earth, fleeting glimpses of movement, stories waiting to be told. By evening, we return to the resort, carrying with us the thrill of sightings and the timeless magic of the wild.

Day 4 : Panna :-

At first light, we set off in the gypsy for our **Third Jungle Safari**, senses sharpened as the wild stirs awake. If luck allows— we will witness the supreme predator tiger, leopard, Indian Dhole or sloth bear. The forest hums with life: peacocks calling, hornbills beating heavy wings, and eagles crying overhead. By 11:00 hrs., we will visit the enchanting Pandav Falls and Caves, nestled amid lush greenery in Panna National Park, this cascading waterfall is a must-visit for nature lovers and adventure seekers alike. Legend has it that the Pandavas of the Indian epic Mahabharata fame found refuge in the ancient caves surrounding the falls, adding a touch of mystique to this already magical place. Return to the resort by 12 noon and ready for well-earned rest.

Post lunch, we set out for our **Fourth Jungle Safari**, venturing into the wilderness as the late-afternoon sun bathes the forest in a warm amber glow, with animals becoming more active as dusk approaches. By 18:30 hrs., we return from the adventure, carrying fresh memories and treasured captures and unforgettable series of safaris.

Day 5 : Panna - Khajuraho - Jabalpur :- (280 kms. 7 hrs.)

At Sunrise, we set out in the gypsy for our **Fifth and Final Safari**—one last chance to glimpse the tiger or whatever surprise Panna may hold. By 11:00 hrs., we return to the resort, ready to pack up with memories of the wild still fresh. After Lunch, around 13:00 hrs., we will transfer you to Jabalpur Railway Station to board the Garibrath Express at 19:30 hrs., setting course for Mumbai.

Day 6 : Mumbai - Pune

Arrive at Mumbai (CST) at 12:20 hrs. After lunch we will board the train to reach Pune in the evening.
