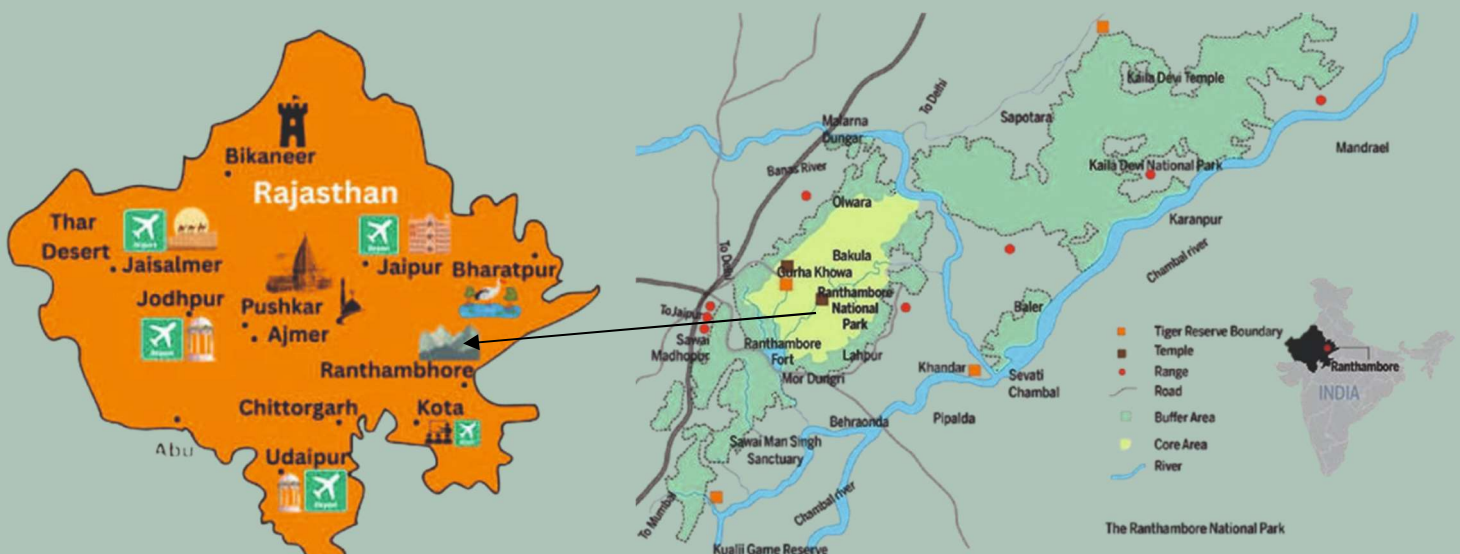


Whispers of Nature: The Soul of Ranthambore

Ranthambore National Park is a beautiful wildlife haven in northern India, known for its expansive 275 km² core area and a total span of 392 km², including the buffer zone. Nestled at an elevation of 215 to 505 meters above sea level, it's located in the Sawai Madhopur district of southeastern Rajasthan, around 180 km from Jaipur, which is also the closest airport. The charming town of Sawai Madhopur, just 11 km away, offers the nearest railway station. This park has a rich history—it began as the Sawai Madhopur Game Sanctuary in 1955, became a Project Tiger reserve in 1973, and officially gained national park status in 1980. Later, in 1984, the neighbouring forests were recognised as the Sawai Man Singh and Keoladevi Sanctuaries, which were integrated into the tiger reserve in 1991, creating an even larger haven for wildlife enthusiasts to explore. Ranthambore Wildlife Sanctuary is famous for its tigers and is one of the best spots in India to catch a glimpse of these incredible creatures in their natural jungle habitat. What's amazing is that you can often spot them even during the daytime! If you're planning a trip, try visiting between November and May, when the dry deciduous forests make tiger sightings more likely. These forests were once part of the grand jungles of Central India, adding to the park's charm. Nestled on the edge of a plateau, the park is bordered by the Banas River in the north and the Chambal River in the south, and it features some beautiful lakes. The sanctuary is also named after the historic Ranthambore Fortress, which you'll find within the park itself—such a fascinating combination of history and nature!

The landscape here is a beautiful mix of dense tropical dry forests, open bushland, and rocky areas sprinkled with serene lakes and streams. Known for its amazing tiger population, it's one of India's treasured Project Tiger reserves. You'll also find other incredible wildlife like leopards, nilgais, dholes, wild boars, sambars, hyenas, sloth bears, and chitals roaming around. Plus, it's a haven for countless trees, plants, birds, and reptiles. Oh, and don't miss out on seeing one of India's largest banyan trees—it's truly spectacular! Ranthambore National Park, once a renowned hunting ground for the Maharajas of Jaipur, has beautifully transformed into a beloved haven for wildlife enthusiasts and photographers. With its stunning heritage ruins scattered across the park, it offers visitors not just incredible glimpses of tigers and other fascinating wildlife but also a sense of history. Spanning lush greenery and hosting a delightful array of chirping birds and animals, the park truly feels like a magical retreat that's worth experiencing at least once in your life. If you're planning a visit, the best time is between January and June, as the park stays closed during the monsoon months of July and August.

Tour Itinerary for 5 Nights / 6 Days.

Day 1 : Mumbai - Sawai Madhopur :-

We will start our journey from Mumbai in the afternoon by MMCT- JP SF Exps. (Train no. 12955, Time : 19:05 hrs.)
Overnight Journey. (No Food Included)

Day 2: Sawai Madhopur - Ranthambore (20 kms. ½ hr.)

Arriving at Sawai Madhopur Railway Station around 09:20 hrs., we will proceed to the breathtaking Ranthambore National Park, reaching there by approximately 10:30 hrs.

After lunch, we'll set off on our **First Jungle Safari** in a gypsy—how exciting! Ranthambore is famous for its tigers, and we'll keep our eyes peeled to hopefully spot the majestic king of the jungle or perhaps even a leopard. Along the way, we might also catch sight of spotted deer, sambar deer, blue bulls, wild boars, or jackals. And don't forget to look up—vultures, eagles, peacocks, owls, and colorful flycatchers make the jungle even more magical. We'll return to the resort around 18:30 hrs., so be sure to share your safari stories and photos with everyone over a warm cup of tea!

Day 3 : Ranthambore :-

Tomorrow morning, we are heading out for our **Second Jungle Safari** in a Gypsy— It's another wonderful chance to spot tigers and soak up the amazing vibes of Ranthambore's wilderness. We will visit the different Lakes, where you might catch Sambar deer relaxing near the water or even spot some crocodiles chilling on the banks! We will be back at the resort around 11:00 hrs., so don't forget to share your fantastic stories and photos with everyone. After lunch, we will set off on our **Third Jungle Safari**, diving even deeper into the lush forest, with high hopes for more spectacular wildlife sightings.

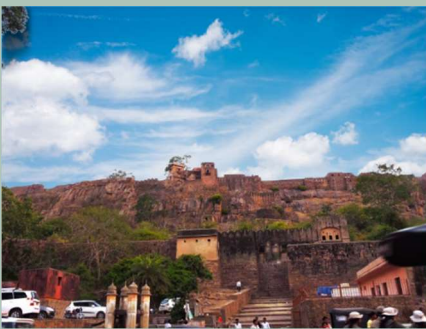
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Day 4 : Ranthambore :-

As the sun rises, we set out on our **Fourth Jungle Safari**, entering the gypsy to explore Ranthambore as the wildlife stirs to life. There is a possibility of encountering a tiger or leopard once more if circumstances permit. The forest resonates with activity, as peacocks call out, Owls flap their strong wings, and eagles emit sharp cries overhead. The journey will cover different areas of Ranthambore with the aim of observing various birds and mammals.

After lunch, you will have some well-deserved rest. Later in the afternoon, we will embark on a soothing visit to Ranthambore Fort, where an easy climb leads you to remarkable views of the lush jungle below. Don't miss exploring the Ganesh Temple and other historic structures on the fort, which carry their own charm and stories. By about 19:00 hrs., we will return to the resort, where a peaceful night's stay awaits you in the serene comforts of the resort.

Day 5 : Ranthambore - Sawai Madhopur :- (20 kms. ½ hr.)

At dawn, we boarded the gypsy for our **Fifth and last Safari**, offering one last opportunity to spot a tiger or encounter other remarkable sights that Ranthambore had to offer. By 11:00 hrs., we returned to the resort with vivid memories of the wilderness. After lunch, scheduled around 13:00 hrs., the plan was to head to Sawai Madhopur Railway Station to catch the JP-Pune Superfast Express at 14:45 hrs., marking the start of our journey back to Pune.
