



## Rivers, Ridges, and Roars: Corbett Unplugged



**Jim Corbett National Park**, India's oldest and most renowned wildlife sanctuary, lies along the Ramganga River at the lower foothills of the Kumaon Himalayas. The park is named after the legendary British-Indian hunter-turned-conservationist, Edward James "Jim" Corbett, who was famous for tracking the man-eaters of Kumaon. For wilderness tourism, the reserve's primary gateways are the Dhikala Tourism Zone (accessed via the Dhangarhi Gate) and the Bijrani Tourism Zone (accessed through the Amdanda Gate). This fabled landscape is globally celebrated for its high density of Royal Bengal Tigers.

Established in 1936 as Hailey National Park, it was originally created to safeguard the endangered Royal Bengal Tiger. Geographically, the park spans latitudes 29°25' to 29°39'N and longitudes 78°44' to 79°07'E. The total reserve encompasses 1,318.54 square kilometres (509.09 sq mi), comprising a core zone of 520 square kilometres (200 sq mi) and a buffer zone of 797.72 square kilometres (308.00 sq mi). This diverse terrain includes rugged hills, riverine belts, marshy depressions, sprawling grasslands, and a grand reservoir. Elevations range from 1,300 to 4,000 feet (400 to 1,220 m), offering crisp, sunny winter days alongside cold nights, with heavy monsoon rains arriving between July and September.

The flora of Corbett mirrors its distinct environmental topography, blending vegetation typical of both the Himalayas and the Gangetic plains. The park hosts a recorded variety of trees, shrubs, herbs, grasses, ferns, and fungi. This botanical abundance serves as a vital habitat and food source for the park's rich animal kingdom. Beyond its thriving tiger population, Corbett supports over fifty mammal species, the largest being the Asiatic Elephant. Four distinct species of deer also thrive here. Additionally, the park acts as a sanctuary for the Gharial, an endangered, fish-eating crocodile found in only a few South Asian rivers; the Ramganga remains one of the best locations to view them in the wild.

**Day 1 : Pune / Mumbai - Delhi :-**

We will start our journey from Pune or Mumbai in the morning by Duronto Exps. / Rajdhani Exps.

**Day 2 : Delhi - Corbett National Park :- ( 225 kms. 5 hrs.)**

We will reach New Delhi / H. Nizammuddin Rly. Stn. at 07:00 hrs. After Breakfast we will proceed for Corbett National Park at around 10:00 hrs. Reach Corbett at around 15:00 hrs., check into the hotel and take rest.  
**Night stay at Resort in Corbett. (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included)**

**Day 3 : Corbett :-**

Early in the morning we will take our **First Jungle Safari** by Gypsy. We have a chance to see the most beautiful animal on this planet 'Tiger'. Elephants, Leopard, Spotted Deer, Blue Bull, Jackal, Wild Boar, Sambar Deer are the animals which can also be sighted. The bird species like Vultures, Eagles, Peacocks, Owls, Flycatchers add to the beauty of the jungle. Come back to Resort at around 11:00 hrs. Share your experiences and photographs with others. After lunch we will take our **Second Jungle Safari** by Gypsy. Come back to Resort at around 19:00 hrs. Share your experiences and photographs with others.

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#### Day 4 : Corbett :-

#### Day 5 : Corbett - Delhi :- ( 225 kms. 5 hrs.)

Early in the morning we will go for Nature Trail in Buffer area of Corbett National Park. This trail introduces us with the Jungle and its flora. Come back to Resort at around 08:00 hrs.

After Breakfast : At around 09:00 hrs., we will transfer you to Ramnagar Rly. Stn. to board a train to Delhi at 10:00 hrs. Reach Delhi Rly. Stn. At 15:25 hrs. Board a train from H. Nizammuddin Rly. Stn. to Mumbai at 16:50 hrs. OR Take a flight to Pune / Mumbai at additional cost.

**Overnight Journey. (Breakfast and Lunch Included.)**

#### Day 6 : Mumbai - Pune

Arrive at Mumbai (MMCT) at 08:15 am. We will proceed to Pune by road. Reach Pune at 13:30 hrs.  
**(No Food Included)**
